What is ESERA & how is it regulated in Eswatini?

Legal Mandate ESERA was established by an act of parliament, the Energy Regulatory Act, 2007, which gives it the statutory right to regulate the electric power industry in Eswatini. The establishment of ESERA by legislation enhances the credibility of the institution and is likely to have a positive impact on investor and consumer confidence.

Does Eswatini have a licensing framework?

There is a medium level of development of the licensing framework in Eswatini. The existing licensing framework developed by ESERA covers only grid-connected systems and provides procedures and guidelines for application, approval process, schedule of license fees. There is no simplified licensing framework for off-grid and small systems.
