

Where is Morocco located?

Morocco,[d]officially the Kingdom of Morocco,[e]is a country in the Maghreb region of North Africa. It overlooks the Mediterranean Sea to the north and the Atlantic Ocean to the west,and has land borders with Algeria to the east,and the disputed territory of Western Sahara to the south.

What is Morocco known for?

The Kingdom of Morocco is the most westerly of the North African countries known as the Maghreb - "the West". It has Atlantic and Mediterranean coastlines,a rugged mountain interior and a history of independencenot shared by its neighbours. Its culture is a blend of Arab,Berber,European and African influences.

What are the major ports in Morocco?

Morocco's largest city and major Atlantic Ocean port is Casablanca,an industrial and commercial centre. The capital,Rabat,lies a short distance to the north on the Atlantic coast. Other port cities include Tangier,on the Strait of Gibraltar,Agadir,on the Atlantic,and Al-Hoceïma,on the Mediterranean Sea.

Why is Morocco a European country?

The direct exposure to the North Atlantic Ocean,the proximity to mainland Europeand the long stretched Rif and Atlas mountains are the factors of the rather European-like climate in the northern half of the country. That makes Morocco a country of contrasts. Forested areas cover about 12% of the country while arable land accounts for 18%.

What is the capital city of Morocco?

Morocco's capital city is Rabat; its largest city is its main port,Casablanca. Other cities recording a population over 500,000 in the 2014 Moroccan census are Fes,Marrakesh,Meknes,Salé and Tangier. Morocco is represented in the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 geographical encoding standard by the symbol MA.

Which countries border Morocco?

Morocco has a coast by the Atlantic Ocean that reaches past the Strait of Gibraltar into the Mediterranean Sea. It is bordered by Spain to the north (a water border through the Strait and land borders with three small Spanish-controlled exclaves, Ceuta, Melilla, and Peñón de Vélez de la Gomera), Algeria to the east, and Western Sahara to the south.
